

Cowichan Inpatient Care & Long Term Care Mentorship Program

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Cowichan mentorship program has been developed in collaboration with the UBC Rural CPD Coaching and Mentoring Program (CAMP). The program matches mentees with an experienced local physician mentor. Mentors share knowledge, provide orientations and introductions, offer general support and familiarization, with a goal to have mentees working comfortably and confidently in hospital and/or in long-term care facilities in Cowichan.

This program is funded through the Cowichan Division of Family Practice and accredited through UBC, with participants able to earn credits based on participation in CAMP learning sessions. Read more on the UBC site [here](#). *Please note, participation in CAMP activities is optional.*

OBJECTIVES

With this program, we aim to...

- Orient you to Cowichan District Hospital and/or long-term care sites
- Familiarize you with facility administration teams
- Introduce you to FP and specialist colleagues and allied health professionals
- Assist you in understanding referral and ordering processes
- Introduce you to IT and EMR systems
- Assist you in understanding call systems and in establishing on-call support
- Direct you to local community services, resources and amenities.
- Assist you in establishing a strong network of social and professional support
- Help you feel confident in undertaking facility based work in Cowichan
- Create stability and sustainability in facility based care settings

- ✓ New family practice grads
- ✓ Family doctors new to the Cowichan area
- ✓ FP locums looking to take on facility-based work
- ✓ Established Cowichan FPs looking to start or return to facility-based work
- ✓ PRA and ROS physicians

ELIGIBILITY:

- ➔ Must be working the majority of your time in the CVDFP catchment area
- ➔ Must intend to provide inpatient care and/or long-term care in Cowichan for a minimum of two years
- ➔ *Note: NPs are eligible to participate but cannot receive a CVDFP stipend due to limitations on Division funding*

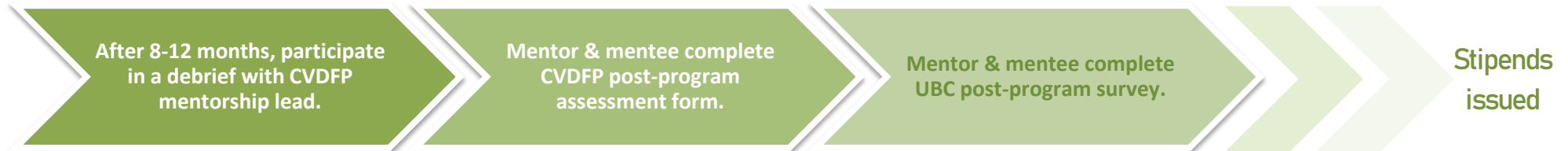
STEPS TO THE PROGRAM

REMUNERATION

CVDFP is pleased to be able to offer a mentorship stipend both to our dedicated mentors and to our mentee participants, based on their commitment to doing inpatient care or long term care in Cowichan.

Upon successful completion of the program, generally considered to be after 12 months, both mentor and mentee will receive a flat stipend of \$2,200, paid by CVDFP.
